ATA Southwest Camp 2024 Friendly Pines Camp , Prescott AZ

Encompassed in the Prescott National Forest this camp has weather that is nearly perfect year-round. At 6,300 elevation there are over 130 acres of land. On the property, there are Many hiking trails, a lake to canoe, kayak, or meditate in a large meadow. There is a challenge course build in the forest amongst the pines that also feature a zip-line, lead of faith and climbing wall.

Over the 3-day camp there will be 48 martial arts based classes being offered to choose from so that there is something for everyone from traditional martial arts, weapons, sparring, combat, ATA MAX, creative, demo teams, street self defense, Taiko and a specific track to learn how to become an ATA Instructor or Jr. Instructor.
